Hello Team,

The Government of Canada has announced that as of Saturday, October 1st, all COVID-19 entry restrictions including use of the ArriveCAN app, as well as testing, quarantine, and isolation requirements for anyone entering Canada will be removed. Transport Canada is also removing the requirement for passengers to undergo pre-departure health checks or wear masks beyond security and onboard aircraft.

Masks are now a personal choice and no longer mandated; however, the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) advises that Masks are still one of the most effective individual public health measures that we can use to protect ourselves and others from COVID-19. PHAC says that, when layered with other public health measures, a well-constructed, well-fitting, and properly worn mask can help prevent you from getting COVID-19 and from spreading COVID-19 to others. <u>PHAC's website</u> has full guidance on the use of masks.

We encourage and support the use of masks in any situations you feel a mask would provide you additional protection.

As has been the case for some time now, individual airports can set their own COVID-19 protocols including the continued placement of plexiglass barriers at check-in and gates. Please ensure you are following the protocols in place at your local airport.
